

Town Hall of the Main Town of Gdansk - a representative seat of the Hanseatic Authorities, having been rebuilt several times since Middle Ages.

1995 - 1997 - works on the Gothic - Renaissance elevations of the body, conservation of brick fragments (1400 m²) and stone and jointless floor architectural decoration. Through examination of multicentural layers on elevations, enabled conservation and reconstruction of the Renaissance polychromy.

Conservation of XVI c. sundial-dismantle and conservation of metal-plate and it's painted decorations as well as gilding.

1997-1998 - research and examination of the internal yard elevations.
