Town Hall of the Main Town of Gdansk - a representative seat of the Hanseatic Authorities, having been rebuilt several times since Middle Ages.

1995 - 1997 - works on the Gothic - Rennaissance elevations of the body, conservation of brick fragments (1400 m2) and stone and jointless floor architektural decoration. Through examination of multicentural layers on elevations, enabled conservation and reconstruction of the Rennaissance polychromy.

Conservation of XVI c. sundial-dismantle and conservation of metal-plate and it's painted decorations as well as gilding.

1997-1998 - research and examination of the internal yard elevations.
