

Carmelite Nunnery in Krakow - the Baroque cloister on Kopernik Street in Krakow.

1997 - 1999 - conservation of stoneworks in black marble on the front yard. Conservation of the surrounding wall, chambers of which were covered with XVIII c. Stations of the Cross in place of some scenes "Arma Christi" were depicted on the background of clouds. 2000 - 2001 - conservation of the Baroque wooden interior of the church; side altars, pulpit and choir. The marbling which was partly recontructed had been uncovered from under layers of paintings.

2002 - 2003 - conservation of the Baroque, wooden furnishing of the vestry.
