



Barbican in Krakow - XV c. fortification of St. Florian Gate, part of Medieval city walls of Krakow.

2000 - research of the causes for destructions of this unique brick fortification and selection of conservation methods.

Since 2001 - conservation of the lower part of round walls. Due to the fact that the significant part of outer wall has fallen into layers, the anchoring of layers and joining of the cracked core of the wall has been done. The anchoring bars have been set in the holes in the same holes foamed mineral ferment has been inserted to complete the lacks. Numerous cracks in the torrets of the barbican have been repaired.

As a result of research carried out in 2000-2001, it has been possible to uncover Medieval walls of the foregate from under modern coverings and batch. This enabled the beginning of designing the plan to reconstruct the Kleparz Bridge.

2002 - 2003 - countinuation of conservation of brick elevation of the outer Barbican, also paving-stones have been laid.
