



**Vestry at St Jan Cathedral in Wrocław**- brick building, being an integral part of the cathedral constructed and changed from XIII<sup>th</sup> XV<sup>th</sup> centuries. It is composed of two parts: eastern one, two- floor tall, called “Vestry of Bishop Nanker” and western one-floor tall, called “vestry of monks”.

In 2003 we have accomplished a technical and esthetic conservation of brick fragments and of the stonework on the vestry elevations.
